Taichung City Da Dun Cultural Exchange Exhibition

Institute of Texan Cultures showcases latest art from Taiwan

WHAT:

The Institute of Texan Cultures will host the Taichung City Da Dun Cultural Exchange Exhibition, introducing an American audience to the latest artistic developments from Taiwan. Established in 1996 as an opportunity for Taiwanese artists to learn from one another, the exhibition has expanded to a global scale. Its mission is to boost the aura of artistic creation, to cultivate artistic talents and to promote artistic exchanges.

About 2,000 artists submitted works in 11 categories: crafts, sculpture, digital art, photography, printmaking, watercolor painting, oil painting, glue color painting, seal engraving, calligraphy, and ink wash painting. The cultural exchange in San Antonio incorporates 110 art pieces, including some works of previous Da Dun prize winners and the winning pieces of the 13th annual Da Dun Exhibition.

The Taichung City Da Dun Cultural Exchange Exhibition in San Antonio is sponsored by Cultural Affairs Bureau of Taichung City, Taiwan, the East Asia Institute, the Institute of Texan Cultures and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office of Houston.
